### Centennial Scholars Entrance Award 2018/19 - Parent/Guardian Form

Centennial Scholars Entrance Awards (CSEA) assist students in making the transition to UBC from secondary school or another post-secondary institution. The purpose of this program is to financially support academically qualified students who show an interest in joining and contributing to the UBC community, but who would not otherwise be able to attend without significant financial assistance. This program offers entering students renewable awards up to \$40,000, payable over four years. There are opportunities for students studying on UBC's Vancouver campus to receive full-ride awards, ranging in value up to the full cost of a student's program and living expenses.

#### Criteria

The successful candidate:

- Is a strong academic student and meets all UBC admissions requirements
- Demonstrates financial need
- Is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Is entering directly from high school or transferring from another post-secondary institution
- Is applying to a direct entry undergraduate program at UBC and who does not have a previous degree.
- Has a reference from a member of the school or community

#### Instructions

Please **read the instructions carefully** before filling out the Parent/Guardian Form:

- You must have the applicant's UBC Student Number in order to submit the Parent/Guardian Form
- If the applicant has been out of high school for 48 months or less, you must complete the Parent/Guardian Form which asks financial information such as tax, assets, resources, and income regarding you and your spouse or common-law partner (if applicable)
- Once the form is complete, please upload through the <u>Supporting Documentation</u> application
- Parents/Guardians can opt to submit one form on behalf of both parents/guardians or submit the forms separately

### **Timeline**

- Completed applications (including Student, Parental/Guardian Info & Reference) must be received by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017
- All applicants will be notified by May 15, 2018 regarding their status
