PROCEDURES:

1. Submit completed form to: The Indigenous Gather Space, Room A167, Langara College
If you are unable to drop off the form during normal business hours, please email aboriginal@langara.ca.
2. Once you have received your confirmation email, make an appointment with the Aboriginal Liaison Counsellor by emailing aboriginal@langara.ca.
3. When the Transition Plan is complete, request a Statement of Completion from Aboriginal Services to be submitted as part of your application to UBC.

BENEFITS OF THE UBC-LANGARA ABORIGINAL TRANSFER PARTNERSHIP:

- Dedicated scholarships from Langara to Aboriginal students who meet basic criteria, and who have registered in and are completing the Transition Plan
- Entrance scholarships and awards from UBC to Aboriginal students who meet set criteria, including the completion of the Transition Plan at Langara.
