



Tuum Est Award Information Sheet

As a recipient of the Tuum Est Experiential Award, you will be eligible to receive your funds as early as your first year at UBC, though many students will access their funding in their second, third, or fourth year of study, as some experiences take time to plan. You can redeem your award funding within five years of starting at UBC (e.g. if you start at UBC in September 2020 you have until August 2025 to redeem). Continuous enrolment at UBC is required (though summer enrolment is not required). You must participate in a UBC-affiliated approved learning experience (e.g. Go Global, co-operative education, etc.) in order to receive your funds. Experiences are to be in addition to your academic program, rather than a requirement of your program.

Support provided

- UBC will email you details about information sessions for the award and for experiential opportunities. All award recipients are invited to attend.
- You will receive complimentary registration to the Student Leadership Conference for your first year at UBC.

Meet requirements

- A 70% average will qualify you for many opportunities, but please refer to your faculty's co-op website or the Go Global website for specific minimums, application requirements, and evaluation information.
- Remain registered in a minimum of 24 credits during the session in which you redeem your award funding or, if you redeem during Summer Session, during the following Winter Session.

How to redeem

- Once you have secured your experience, complete the [redemption link](#), along with supporting documentation (e.g. co-op job offer, exchange confirmation, etc.) confirming your opportunity.

After you receive your award

After completing your chosen experience, we encourage you to contribute to the UBC community by sharing your experience. This contribution could take many forms:

- Present on your experience/learning from the Student Leadership Conference.
- Share your experience at information sessions for this award.
- Write an online piece (e.g. blog post, student testimonial) about your experience.
- Act as a peer mentor for an incoming Tuum Est Experiential Award recipient.
- Complete another activity that will allow you to share your experience with the UBC community.



To be eligible for other awards

If you wish to be considered for other awards while at UBC, you are encouraged to:

- Pass all courses for which you are registered (no failed courses).
- Maintain a minimum 75% average for Winter Session (September to April) based on the best 24 percentage-graded credits completed.
- Remain registered in a minimum of 24 percentage-graded credits in each Winter Session (September to April).
