# ADDITIONAL NOTES...

- Meet with an Academic Advisor at least once a year to make sure you're on the right path
- If you don't get the classes you want during registration because the class is full, that's totally okay! You can check the Course regularly to see if someone drops it, because chances are they probably will.
- Read the [FAQ section](#) if you're running into any roadblocks with registration first
- Check your [transfer credits](#) here and how it translates in UBCO during your first year.
- Your transfer courses from APs, IBs, and A Levels, will be available around August. Register for your courses as if you haven't received those credits during the registration period. But once those credits have transferred, you can drop the initial courses and register for upper-level courses once you fulfilled the prerequisites.
